

ACRYLIC FABRIC

DIMPLING OR WAFFLING

100% solution dyed acrylic fabric used primarily for external blinds and awnings.

In most cases when a wider width awning skin is manufactured it will require a seam which is an overlap in the fabric where the two pieces are joined. These seams cause bulkiness in the join area and may cause the fabric to gather or bunch when rolled.

With acrylic fabrics, this bunching can cause a waffling or dimpling effect in the awning skin near the seam.

Please be aware that this is not a weakness in the fabric, it is an unavoidable effect of seaming the fabric and will in no way compromise the integrity of the awning skin.
