Cover Strips, Fabric Joints & Valances

PERIMETER COVER STRIP

Every canopy awning is fitted with a cover strip rubber, installed around the entire perimeter—anywhere the frame touches the fabric. This not only protects the fabric from friction and wear but also gives the awning a neat, finished look.

FABRIC SEAM CONSIDERATIONS

While we use only premium materials, no fabric is manufactured in infinite sizes. Depending on the overall dimensions of your awning, fabric seams may be present in the final product. These are carefully placed and finished to maintain a clean, professional appearance.

VALANCE BINDING

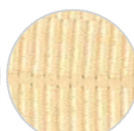
